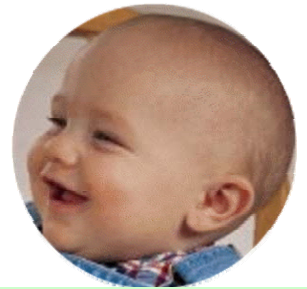

Component	Outcome
What to do with the Mad that you Feel	Parents understand the developmental stages through which preschool children pass in learning self-control and anger management.
Challenging Behaviors	Parents have the opportunity to learn about helping their child develop self-regulation skills.
Relationships are Essential	Parents understand that human connections are essential to learning. Parents learn about establishing nurturing relationships.
How Learning Begins	Parents understand how learning begins. Parents learn about child development.
Social, Emotional and Intellectual Together	Parents understand that social, emotional, and intellectual learning are inextricably linked. Parents learn about establishing nurturing relationships.
Building Confidence and Competence	Parents understand that children receive powerful messages about themselves from the ways that adults respond to and interact with them. Parents learn about modeling constructive behavior.
Understanding Temperament	Parents understand that effective parenting/teaching requires becoming aware of the role that temperament plays in behavior. Parents learn about modeling constructive behavior.
Learning to Read Other's Thoughts and Feelings	Parents understand that children need to learn that what they feel and what others feel can be different. Parents learn about child development.
Encouraging Curiosity and Problem Solving	Parents understand that children are motivated by inborn curiosity and drive to solve problems and figure out how the world works. Parents learn about child development.
Using Language to Make Meaning of Experience	Parents understand how to use language to promote language and literacy skills in children. Parents learn about their child's emergent literacy skills.
Memory and Learning	Parents understand the role of memory in early learning. Parents learn about child development.
Stress and Learning	Parents understand how stress can affect children's growth and development and how to help children and adults manage stress. Parents learn about child development.
